The 24th Biennial Meeting of the Polymer Physics Group

14 -16 September 2009

This is the 24th in a series of conferences dating back to the 1960s, when Andrew Keller and Ian Ward first established the Polymer Physics Group. The meeting has a broad remit, attracting delegates from across the polymer community, and providing a forum for younger members of the community to showcase their work. Ph.D. students are particularly encouraged to attend.

The meeting includes four invited talks and a lecture from the Founders' Prize winner, **Prof. Athene Donald, FRS**. In addition, an early career polymer physicist from the USA will give the DPOLY/PPG exchange lectureship. The remainder of the program will be filled with contributed talks and posters from all areas of polymer science.



The invited speakers are: **Mervyn Miles** (Bristol, Physics); **Henning Sirringhaus** (Cambridge, Physics); **Ralph Colby** (Penn State, Materials Science and Engineering) and **Günter Reiter** (Freiburg, Physics).

The conference will be held in the picturesque surroundings of Wills Hall, at the University of Bristol.
